Jamie Wong won a scholarship for one million dollars to study at Oxford



From now on, we shall open this column to put in some old photos and remind our members events that happened during the life of CCA in the past 26 odd years.


CDNIS – The founding of CDNIS in 1991

1. Donation of the sum of HK\$250,000.00 by Standard Chartered Bank Hong Kong Trustee limited


Through the efforts of Roger Chow, the bank donated the said sum to start the School.

The person on the right is Mr. Ian Robertson, the first principal of CDNIS.




2. Donation of the sum of HK\$400,000.00 by CCA through its efforts by way of a film gala show
